*The restaurant Barga was designed and constructed by the architect and bohemian Keller from Orselina anno 1965.*

*The interior construction and the ceiling of wooden beams originate from a shed of Grison Oberland, which were installed into the ceiling by hard work.*

*The room is decorated by Swiss pine panels on the walls and doors of the year 1683. The floor made of vertical oak wood logs and subtlest laid by hand is originally from an old church steeple.*

*Further you can see three Grison escutcheons, which were signed off on Grison house in 1526.*

*The both seat-backs originate from the head end and side walls of a 300 year old bed.*

*Wrought iron bars made by north-Italian bohemians separate the both levels. For your guard and fortune there's a wooden carved statue of St. Martin in a niche, who's the patron saint of Flims as well.*
